Scope

- Survey of existing initiatives: origin, current situation, future prospect.
- Critical evaluation of these initiatives focusing on impediments and best practices

Urban Development and Transportation Energy Demand

Background

- Robust pace of urban development in APEC and transport energy demand growth in urban areas
- Rising concerns over energy security and air quality problem

Objectives

- Characterisation of transportation energy demand in the major cities of APEC
- Drawing policy implications for enhancement of energy security and sustainable development

Scope

- Analysis of historical trend for urban transport energy demand in APEC
- Survey of environmental problems arising from urban transport energy demand growth
- Evaluation of gasoline/diesel requirements in urban area and refinery production capacities
- Analysis of policy/economic instruments for traffic demand management with case studies
- Projection for future transport energy requirements in the major cities of APEC
