8.c. (1) Objective of PREE

- To provide a broad review of EE goals, EE strategies, institutional setup, and policy measures in all sectors for a volunteer economy.
- To provide recommendations based on best/high performance practices in order to implement best practices in as many economies as possible.
- To hold a forum to further discuss key issues highlighted in the PREEs(integration of Cooperative Energy Efficiency Design for Sustainability (CEEDS)).



8.c. (2) Follow-up PREE

- In 2012, the Follow-Up PREE was designed to assist former PREE host economies to implement the original recommendations from the PREE review teams.
- The objective is to fill the gap between the implementation of energy efficiency action plans and the monitoring and evaluation of those plans.



8. c. (3) Progress of PREE

- A trial Energy Efficiency Policy (EEP) Workshop was held as a Self-Funded project in conjunction with EGEE&C 45 in Singapore
- The trial EEP Workshop focused on the fundamentals of energy efficiency policy making and the development of stable funding mechanisms for agencies and programmes.
- 40 participants including representatives from 14 economies attended the trial EEP Workshop.

8. c. (4) Future Plan of PREE

- The proposal for PREE phase 5 was "finally" approved as APEC Support Fund project at the session 1, 2015.
- The 3rd Follow-up PREE is planned in Thailand in August 2015 for PREE phase 5. It will focus on the transport sector.
- The 1st "EE Policy Workshop" will be held with EGEE&C 47 in the 1st half of 2016 as a part of PREE Phase 5.
