



- China, Singapore, Japan and Korea are major suppliers



### Highlights of Recent Changes in Demand on Oil and Gas in Hong Kong


- Natural Gas is imported from China via submarine pipeline
- Use for power generation and towngas manufacture



#### Notable Development on Oil and Gas in Hong Kong


- Environmental targets for Hong Kong
  - Reduce carbon intensity by 50-60% by 2020 (as compared to 2005)
  - Reduce the emissions of SO2 by 35%-75%,
     NOX by 20%-30% and RSP by 15%- 40%
     by 2020 (as compared to 2010)






#### Notable Development on Oil and Gas in Hong Kong

- Existing natural gas supply from China by submarine pipelines
- Offshore Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) import facility Floating Storage and Regasification Unit (FSRU) to be commissioned by 2020
- FSRU benefits: Gas supply diversity and security, cost competiveness and keep abreast of technological developments





## Notable Development on Oil and Gas in Hong Kong

- No natural reserve of natural gas
- Apart from importation, several landfill sites and biogas production plant in operation to supplement energy supply and reduce greenhouse gases.



#### **APEC Cooperation**

- Explore cooperative measures between economies to safeguard oil and gas supply during emergency period.
- Organize more technical visits, seminars and working group meetings
